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From the Archbishop



My Dear Friends in Christ,

In my first year as archbishop, I have had many opportunities to meet the faith-filled people of the diverse cities, suburbs and rural communities that make up the Archdiocese of Cincinnati. Throughout my journeys, I have come to appreciate just how much Catholic Charities Southwestern Ohio (CCSWO) has made an impact on the lives of the poor and vulnerable among us.

The compassionate work of Catholic Charities, brought about through the efforts of thousands of volunteers and donors, reveals the abundance of faith, hope, and love alive in our local Church. "Love for our neighbor is tangible proof of the authenticity of our love for God," Pope Leo XIV recognized (*Dilexi Te*, no.26).

Reaching out beyond its physical offices, CCSWO offers a variety of services to put love into action. CCSWO's Food for All pantries, for example, extend across six urban and rural counties, feeding those who hunger. Its family development services visits numerous daycare facilities, helping the youngest among us to thrive. Su Casa Hispanic Center and our other migration services organize health fairs, teach English classes, conduct immigration legal clinics, and send interpreters to hospitals and other partner agencies, providing direct assistance to families in neighborhoods, churches and homes throughout the region. Mental health counselors meet with struggling students at area schools. Caregiver programs recruit and assign volunteers to care for our elderly and sick neighbors. Throughout all of this work, staff and volunteers accompany those being helped to share their heartfelt needs, so that the CCSWO team might lift them up in prayer.

As I continue to lead and serve this archdiocese, I am grateful to everyone who makes Catholic Charities' mission possible. Together, we proclaim the Good News that no one is beyond reach to experience God's love. May God bless us in our efforts, so that charity and love may continue to prevail.

Impact. Resilience. Solidarity. These qualities highlight the forefront of Catholic Charities Southwestern Ohio's work in 2025.

Our **impact** was evident in the lives of nearly 24,000 people we helped this year move from crisis to stability and self-sufficiency. Catholic Charities uplifts the most vulnerable families in our region, regardless of their faith and background, and equips them to reach their fullest potential. Our many and unique services fill gaps in the safety nets particular to each community across our 11-county service area. This targeted focus led us to serve thousands more than in other years, including offering life-saving therapy to mental health patients, respite to caregivers caring for sick and elderly loved ones, hope to immigrants seeking emergency assistance and legal counsel, and effective practices to daycare providers addressing difficult childhood behaviors.

The year was also fraught with many external challenges that demanded grit and **resilience** from staff, volunteers, donors and our partners. Drastic disruptions in refugee resettlement and the lives of many of our immigrant neighbors caused traumatic hardships to which the community energetically responded with material and spiritual support. We also weathered unexpected shocks to federal funds, which we managed through careful expense management and an outpouring of private generosity.

All of this was possible thanks to our steady supporters and a major new fundraising initiative, called **Rising Together**. Having completed its first full year in 2025, this multi-million dollar investment in the agency's sustainability and growth represents a greater response of **solidarity** from the community. It came about as the clear answer to a thorough strategic planning process that underscored how extensively stakeholders rely on the distinct and important services of Catholic Charities. Their urging was that we stand firm through adversity and offer more of our services to the many more people and places who need our help.

As a result, more supporters than in recent memory identify themselves as connected to the Catholic Charities' mission of serving, engaging, and empowering people through God's love in their times of vulnerability. We are endlessly grateful for the confidence and encouragement of these donors and volunteers whose gifts of time, talent, and treasure enabled us to serve so many in need and to build the capacity for even greater outcomes ahead.

Soon, we will be opening a new facility in Butler County as well as organizing new food pantries to underserved communities there. We are expanding our education and employment services. New initiatives to support homebound seniors and caregivers are underway, and our family development programs are being introduced in new regions. In addition, our commitment to the lives and human dignity of refugees and migrants remains unwavering and fortified by our Christian convictions.

To all of you who put God's love into action through the work of Catholic Charities, thank you! May the Holy Spirit continue to guide and inspire all that we do, so that, through our ongoing impact, resilience, and solidarity, everyone can rise together to ensure their God-given human dignity.

Early Intervention That Changes a Child's Trajectory

Janie, a three-year-old facing severe behavioral challenges, was on the verge of preschool expulsion when our Early Childhood Mental Health consultant stepped in. Through observation and family engagement, the consultant identified the need to address her trauma. With the right supports in place and a referral to partners, the child's language, behavior, and emotional regulation improved dramatically. She is among the hundreds of children who are now thriving in their classrooms and no longer at risk of expulsion due to our interventions.

SENIOR & CAREGIVER SUPPORT

Despite a year of federal funding disruption, our AmeriCorps Seniors programs persevered. In the Fall of 2025, we expanded our reach by launching *Kindred Companions* in local parishes. Rooted in Catholic social teaching, *Kindred Companions* empowers volunteers to walk alongside older adults so they can age in place with dignity and connection.

A Steady Presence for Seniors in Need

Jackie, a dedicated Senior Companion volunteer in Clermont County, supports three older adults who rely on her weekly visits. She provides essential respite for two families caring for aging loved ones, and she is a lifeline for another neighbor who has no family or transportation to medical appointments. Her presence brings comfort, stability, and connection to each person she serves. She and other Senior Companions ensured that 96% of our homebound clients in need were able to live more independently.

Answering Hunger with Hope:

Three Generations Serving Through Food for All

In Ripley, Ohio, access to fresh food is limited. A few dollar stores and gas stations offer basic items, but there is no full grocery store, and for many residents living on fixed or limited incomes, transportation to larger towns is out of reach. The need for reliable food access is constant and deeply felt.

That's why, in 2016, when Pastor Jim Settles of Christian Methodist Episcopal Church was asked to identify a community leader to help launch Catholic Charities Southwestern Ohio's new Food for All pantry, he immediately thought of Candye Dudley. Known for her compassion and steady presence, Candye stepped into the role without hesitation.

"We set it up like a little grocery store. People would roll through to figure out what they wanted," she recalls. It is so important for "filling a need."

Through volunteers like Candye, the Food for All program brings fresh, healthy food to communities across Adams, Brown, Butler, Clermont, Clinton, Hamilton, and Highland Counties, places where affordable groceries are scarce. The program also provides PowerPack weekend meals to low-income students in inner-city schools, ensuring children have nutritious food when school cafeterias are closed.

Candye's service quickly became a family calling. Her daughter, Amber, and granddaughter, Niya, joined her in volunteering, creating a three-generation ministry of compassion.

"I'm really impressed with them following me. It makes me feel good that they know the value of volunteering. They know how important it is to offer more of yourself," Candye says.

For Niya, now the pastor at Beebe Chapel Christian Methodist Episcopal Church in Ripley, serving alongside her mother and grandmother is both

joyful and deeply rooted in her faith. **"The volunteer work means everything to me. It's like the Bible says about helping those who are widows and orphans. So being able to be a part of this is a great thing."**

Candye says one of the greatest blessings of her work is reconnecting with neighbors she might not otherwise see. In a town with few gathering places, the pantry has become a point of fellowship and community.

"I've met so many good people, not only if they're coming to get the service, but also working with people. It's just good fellowship," she says. The experience, she adds, is "complete enjoyment."

Niya feels the same, and she sees firsthand how great the need remains. "All of these people who are coming through the drive thru makes it obvious that there's a lot more work for us to do as believers."

In that spirit, she encourages others to get involved, spread the word, and help ensure that families in Ripley and beyond continue to receive the nourishment and hope that they deserve.

From Pain to Peace:

Stories of Courage and Renewal

When people walk through the doors of Catholic Charities Southwestern Ohio seeking mental health support, many arrive carrying heavy burdens, including grief, fear, loneliness, or the feeling that life has become too much to bear. Jenny* was one of them. She remembers the moment clearly. She was feeling sad, rejected, and abandoned by her husband, and she knew she needed help.

She found that help in Catholic Charities' Mental Health Services program.

Jenny's story reflects a reality faced by millions. Each year, 1 in 5 adults in the United States experiences mental illness. Yet mental health is often overlooked, misunderstood, or stigmatized. Catholic Charities believes that emotional well being is essential for individuals, families, and communities to thrive, and that compassionate, accessible care can change lives.

The Mental Health Services program provides evidence based support for people of all ages, helping them build resilience, strengthen relationships, and rediscover hope. Every person begins with a diagnostic assessment with a licensed therapist, who offers a mental health diagnosis and personalized recommendations. Treatment may include individual counseling, family therapy, group sessions, or psychiatric care, all tailored to the individual's goals and needs.

Jenny has been attending counseling for two years, and the transformation has been profound. **"The counseling has helped me learn to love myself. I learned that I cannot expect self-respect from others, but rather I need to respect myself. I also learned that I have value as a person,"** she shares.

Her message to others is rooted in both faith and courage: "First, we need to rely on God. Then, we need to look for professional help so we can deal with our

pain and suffering. I think that people should get help with therapy. It is important to not be afraid of asking for help."

Jenny's journey is just one example of the healing made possible through Catholic Charities' mental health programs.

Alicia's* story is another. Before being diagnosed with Bipolar 1 Disorder, she says she "had highs and lows for a long time." Her life felt unpredictable and overwhelming. After receiving an assessment, therapy, and psychiatric support, she began to experience stability and hope.

"I feel a lot better," she explains. "My relationship with my husband has improved significantly. We go to church together and are able to communicate a lot better. I have a great quality of life, despite my diagnosis."

One of the most meaningful changes for Alicia has been the return of her lifelong love of reading, something she had been unable to enjoy for years.

"I am so grateful to the Catholic Charities mental health team for their support," she says. **"My life has changed. I have never been so healthy and happy with myself and my family life."**

Together, Jenny and Alicia's stories reveal the heart of Catholic Charities' mission: to walk with people through their pain, help them rediscover their strength, and support them as they build lives filled with dignity, connection, and peace.

From Caregiver to Companion: *Gerry's Gift of Presence*

Caring for a loved one with a chronic or degenerative illness is an act of profound love, and often, profound exhaustion. Millions of Americans shoulder that responsibility every day, navigating medical decisions, emotional strain, and long stretches of isolation.

Gerry Weller knows that journey too well. For years, she cared for her husband as he lived with Alzheimer's disease. During that time, she attended support group meetings through Catholic Charities Southwestern Ohio's Caregiver Assistance Network (CAN). Only later, after her husband passed away, did she realize how much those services had meant to her, and how much she still had to offer others walking the same road.

When she was invited to volunteer for Catholic Charities' CAN program, she said yes. She began assisting and supporting the facilitator of the program. She also became a peer mentor, offering encouragement rooted in lived experience.

"By that time, I was looking for something to do," she says.

In her volunteer role, Gerry accompanies caregivers through moments she remembers all too well. **"I've gotten a lot of self-satisfaction out of volunteering," she shares. "It's special to me to see laughter, friendship, true joy among folks who are coping with this disease."**

Her own caregiving journey gives her a unique perspective and a desire to help others avoid the loneliness she once felt. Gerry cared for her husband during the pandemic, a time she recalls as deeply isolating. "Sometimes I learn things I wish I would have known with my husband," she notes. Those moments become opportunities to share wisdom she gained the hard way.

Her background as an early childhood educator has unexpectedly enriched her service. The patience, creativity, and adaptability she honed in the classroom



now help her support caregivers with compassion and clarity. **"I feel successful in adapting my skills as an early childhood educator to the needs of seniors experiencing dementia,"** she says.

Gerry encourages caregivers to seek support early, not only when the challenges become overwhelming. "I think people wait until they really need a service where they would have benefited earlier if they would have gotten involved," she explains.

This summer, her granddaughter will join her as a volunteer with Creative Connections as part of her school's community service requirements. Now a new generation is continuing the family's legacy of care. Gerry wonders if it might be because of what she witnessed during her grandfather's illness.

For Gerry, volunteering with CAN is more than service. "I love every minute I do it," she shares. "I feel like when I volunteer, I give back in my husband's name."

Walking Beside Diego: *A Journey Toward Safety and Hope*

For many immigrants, coming to the United States can mean hope and a chance to build a better life for themselves and their families. But the journey can also be filled with fear, uncertainty, and challenges that are difficult to navigate alone. Diego* understands this reality deeply.

He arrived from Chiapas, Mexico, in 2018 after being recruited by traffickers who promised him legitimate employment and assistance applying for a work visa. Believing he would be able to support his family, he left behind his wife and two young children and made the difficult journey north. But when he arrived in the United States, he was told there was no job. His family in Mexico was then extorted for his release, and Diego was threatened, leaving him too fearful to return home.

Trying to rebuild his life, he found work in construction. But the trauma he had endured, combined with complications related to his immigration status, left him vulnerable and unsure of where to turn. After a frightening encounter with ICE on his way to work, Diego reached out to Catholic Charities Southwestern Ohio for help.

He was connected with our Immigration Legal Services program, which provides immigrants with representation and guidance as they navigate the complex and ever changing immigration system.

Elizabeth Clapp, Director of Catholic Charities' Immigration Legal Services program, understands why so many immigrants feel overwhelmed. "Not only is immigration law extremely complex but immigration policies and regulations frequently change. It can be difficult for lawyers to understand, let alone migrants who come from other cultures and don't speak English as a first language," she explains. **"The system has become increasingly difficult for immigrants."**

Diego

Last year, our Immigration Legal Services team worked closely with Diego to address his situation. Because he had been deceived, exploited, and threatened by traffickers, he qualified to apply for a T visa, a form of immigration relief available to victims of severe human trafficking who are working toward safety and stability. With support from Catholic Charities, Diego says he now feels hopeful, supported, and far more secure about his future.

Diego is one of nearly two thousand meaningfully helped through Catholic Charities' Immigration Legal Services. The team also processed 320 green card applications and naturalizations, empowering clients towards legal permanent residency as well as 227 employment authorizations, 30 Deferred Action for Childhood arrivals and 21 asylum cases.

While our Immigration Legal Services play a vital role in helping newcomers navigate legal challenges, they are only one part of the comprehensive support Catholic Charities offers to migrants and refugees. Through Education Services, adults access ESOL and digital literacy classes that build the language and workforce

skills needed for daily life and long term integration.

Refugee Support Services welcomes individuals and families fleeing war, violence, and persecution, accompanying them as they rebuild their lives and work toward self sufficiency. And at Su Casa Hispanic Center, Hispanic/Latino families across the tri state region receive culturally responsive support. This includes emergency assistance, case management, and health promotion services. All designed to strengthen stability and empower each household on its path forward.

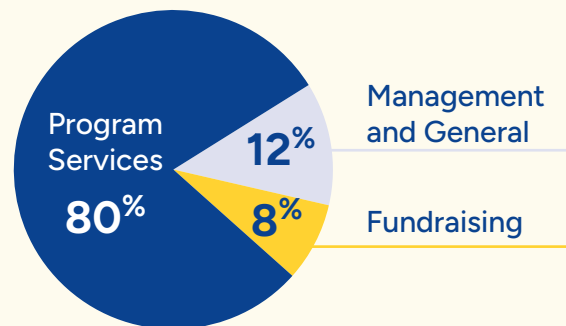
